



REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS

SELECTION POLICY

This policy applies to the selection of players to represent Perth Netball Association in the Metro League Competition and State Association Championships. Refer also to PNA By-Law 11.0 "Association Teams".

1.0 Selection Trials

- 1.1 Perth Netball Association representative teams will be selected from trials conducted at a time to be determined by the Association.
- 1.2 The dates and times of selection trials will be advertised by the Association and will be open to all eligible players.
- 1.3 Players will be selected based on their performance at trials. Previous years' selection in representative teams will not guarantee selection in the current year's team.

2.0 Inability to Attend

- 2.1 If a player is unable to attend a selection trial date, they must submit appropriate documentation in writing to the PNA Administrator in order to be eligible for selection.
- 2.2 The documentation must fully detail the reasons for non-attendance. If the circumstances involves a medical condition, the complexity and severity of the condition and estimated recovery time of the illness or injury must be included.
- 2.3 The Selection Committee will determine whether injured or ill players are eligible for team selections based on medical advice or clearance.
- 2.4 Any player unavailable to participate in selection trials and who has been granted leave to be considered for the team will be considered for selection based on current year performance.

3.0 Nominated Playing Positions

The Selection Panel will assess players in a minimum of two of their nominated positions and as far as possible players should be given a reasonable amount of playing time relative to other players during the trials.

4.0 Parent Coaches

It is preferable that no Parent or Guardian is involved in the coaching of their own child. However, if PNA determines it to be in the best interest of the program, they may appoint a parent of a player as a Coach, subject to PNA Executive Committee approval.

5.0 Player Fees

- 5.1 All players will be required to pay a player fee prior to the Association Championships that will be determined annually by the Executive. This fee must be paid in full prior to the Championships.
- 5.2 No refunds apply for withdrawals unless for medical reasons (certification from a doctor or medical practitioner must be provided)
- 5.3 Players selected as 'train-ons' will not be charged the full fee amount, unless they are selected in the final team.

6.0 Player Game Time Policy – Association Championships

- 6.1 All coaches will rotate court time for their players throughout the Competition and keep a record of time allocated off for each player. Players must play a minimum of 50% over the carnival (excluding finals).
- 6.2 During finals, the Coach will use their discretion in selecting the team which is best suited for that game.

7.0 Player Game Time Policy – Metro League
